DUH SEMAL SC

The late HUGH H. MACKAY was Vice-President of Maritime Beverages Limited and served on its Board of Directors and those of its progenitor companies for nearly 30 years. He saw overseas service in the Army during World War II and attained the rank of Major before returning to Canada in 1946. On his return to civilian life, he



joined the firm of Pitfield Mackay where he was a Director for many years. He was also a Director of Great Pacific Industries Limited, and until its merger with Genstar was a Director of Canada Permanent Trust Company. Mr. Mackay was also a former President of Ducks Unlimited Canada and continued to take an active interest in the affairs of Ducks Unlimited as a Maritime Director until the time of his death. Known affectionately as "Ylp", his presence is missed by many people.



The Late JAMES A. MacMURRAY, LL.D., was Chairman of MacMurray Foundation Inc., and had a long and distinguished business career. Among his diverse business interests he was Co-founder, President and Chairman of Fundy Cablevision Ltd. in Saint John, NB, President of Eastern Securities Co. Ltd., Chair-Securities Co. Lt

Ltd., a Director of Bank of Canada, Bruncor Inc., Mew Brunswick Telephone Co., Sobey Stores Ltd., and Smelting Co., Empire Co., Sobey Stores Ltd., as well as a number of other Maritime-based companies. He was actively involved in many charitable organizations and was Chairman of Jeux Canada Games Foundation, a Director of Loch Community endeavours. In recognition of his achievements and service to the Community, he achievements and service to the Community, he achievements and service to the Order of Canada. He was awarded honorary Doctor of Laws Degrees by the University of New Brunswick and Mount Allison University, and was appointed a Laureate of the New Brunswick Business Hall of Fame.
